## Instructions for Accessing Online OGS Maps

### Tip

Before searching the OGS site, consult the paper OGS map indexes in the Map Library. They indicate: what's available, the publication number and title, series title, etc.

1. Access Geology Ontario [ <http://www.geologyontario.mndm.gov.on.ca/> ].
2. From the main page, select "Search OGS Publications (OGS Pub)".
3. Enter a Publication Title keyword, i.e. niagara, in the **searching interface**.

If known, make other selections from the drop down options, such as a Series title from the "Pick List".

Once terms are entered, select the "Search" button
