

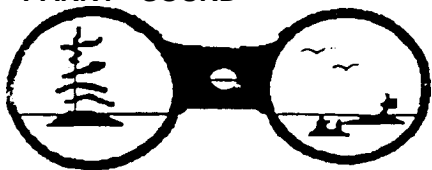
Nature Club offers education outings this summer
