

CUSTOM SYNTHESIS by TDC RESEARCH, Inc.

To follow up on our conversation regarding TDC Research Custom Synthesis program: Here is a brief description of what we can/will do in the custom synthesis area. If you need recent references from people we worked for I can supply them to you. We have a little brochure but it has not been updated in a while so I am doing it by e-mail.

We perform three types of contracts, resynthesis (A), research (B), and (C) annual FTE projects

Types of contracts:

A. Resynthesis. We will perform re-synthesis and scale up of any length for any compound up to 500 g. Occasionally we will do kilo scale work if the synthesis is short and straight forward. We assume that the work in this category is either published or patented or that the customer supplies previously worked out procedure performed at smaller scale.

The quotes and delivery times for work in this category are binding.

B. Research. In this type of project there is no set quote or delivery. We perform the synthesis of (usually) previously not synthesized materials and/or high risk projects on a best effort basis. Every two weeks we submit a detailed report and invoice covering the period. Either party may terminate the project if insufficient progress is made or if dead end is reached.

For both types of work we sign confidentiality agreements. We do NOT perform GMP or radioactive tracer work.

I hope this information is helpful and I look forward to adding you to our customer list. Even though we have never advertized our services we are reasonably well known within the pharmaceutical and agrochemical industry and have an excellent credibility record, although we tend to be more expensive than average custom synthesis houses (but,...you get what you pay for!).

C. Annual retainers or FTEs. These are negotiated, usually after a relationship in service has been established with the customer. The FTE charges vary with projects in the \$110-145/year range.
