- Candidate's most recent teaching dossier (including statement of teaching philosophy, curriculum vitae, and evidence of teaching excellence).

Please submit the completed application package to CTLET by March 31st annually. The Adjudication Committee will make its recommendation to the Vice-President Academic by April 30, with appointments effective July 1.
