**** Applications for admission to a second or subsequent degree, or from a certificate to a degree, should be made as early as possible. Application forms should be submitted by June 1 to ensure consideration for September registration, or by November 1 for January registration.**

REQUIREMENTS

With the exception of the BA/BEd, BPhEd/BEd and BSc/BEd degrees, students may not pursue two undergraduate degrees concurrently.

- An individual who wishes to pursue a second undergraduate degree (e.g., a BA after a BPhEd) must:
 - have successfully completed the first degree **and**
 - make application for admission and be admitted to the second degree program (see Admissions for further information) **and**
 - fulfill all the specific requirements of each degree program including prerequisites, co-requisites, and honours standing requirements (where appropriate).
- To obtain a second degree, students must have completed, with satisfactory standing, at least 50 per cent more credits beyond the first degree. The minimum total credits for both degrees are:
 - for a 3 year (15 credits) degree and a second 3 year (15 credits) degree: 23 credits
 - for a 3 year (15 credits) degree and a 4 year or honours (20 credits) degree: 28 credits
 - for a 4 year or honours (20 credits) degree and a 3 year (15 credits) degree: 28 credits
 - for a 4 year or honours (20 credits) degree and a second 4 year or honours (20 credits) degree: 30 credits
- An applicant who has a bachelor's degree from Brock or another institution may be allowed to pursue undergraduate studies leading to a second bachelor's degree of the same or another designation under the following conditions:
 - the principal area of study or academic emphasis must be distinct from that of the first degree;
 - the student must complete, with satisfactory standing, at least 50 percent more credits beyond the first degree (see required number of credits above);
 - the student must meet all program requirements for the second degree;
 - any departure from the above must be approved by the Dean of the appropriate Faculty.
- For any second degree, an individual may take only those 1(alpha)00 level courses specifically required to fulfil the requirements for the second degree. Electives must be at the 2(alpha)00 level or above.
- An individual who wishes to pursue a certificate program following the completion of a degree or diploma from a university or community college will be limited to no more than one transfer credit from all courses included in the university degree or college diploma.

Certificate to Undergraduate Degree

Individuals wishing to hold both a degree and a certificate must fulfill the requirements for both the degree and certificate. All credits earned in a certificate program are transferable to a degree program as long as they fit within the degree requirements.
