

Brock University Step-by-Step Teacher Education Application Guide

Step 1: Choose a program division

- Carefully review all three divisions and division requirements to ensure you choose the right program. Please review the [Fall 2022 General Admissions Criteria](#) to review the division specific requirements.

Step 2: Submit the TEAS Application through OUAC

- TEAS applications open via [OUAC](#) in September 2021 for the September 2022 term. Please review our Important Dates and Submission Deadlines

Step 3: Request/Submit Documents

- We strongly advise you to order your official transcripts for all Ontario postsecondary institutions you attend(ed) as soon as you submit your TEAS application. Complete the TEAS Transcript Request Form (TRF) and submit it with the TEAS application.
- All documents need to be received by Brock University no later than December 10, 2021.
- You may also upload transcripts through your Brock Student Portal. Supporting Documents are considered unofficial and are used by Admissions to continue the processing of an applicant's file in a timely manner. All uploaded transcripts must include the applicant's full name, the name of the institution attended, and the grades awarded. With an offer of admission, a conditional decision will be given, and students will be required to submit official transcripts sent directly from the home university.

Applicants applying for the [Junior/Intermediate \(B20\)](#) or [Intermediate/Senior \(B30\)](#) divisions must meet the requirements for their teachable subject(s).

- For the Junior/Intermediate division, a minimum **two out of three** teaching subject credits must be completed (with final grades) by December 10, 2021.
- For the Intermediate/Senior division, a minimum, **three out of five first teaching subject credits**, and a minimum of **two out of three second teaching subject credits** must be completed (with final grades) by December 10, 2021

*Teachable subject credits not completed by the application deadline must show as 'in progress' on the transcript submitted at the time of application.

Step 4: Complete your Experience Profile by December 10, 2021

- In addition to meeting the minimum and division-specific requirements, applicants must submit an [Experience Profile](#) that is worth 50% of the application evaluation. You will be able to access your Experience Profile after you have submitted your OUAC TEAS application. Brock will send you an email to acknowledge the receipt of your application. In the acknowledgement you will receive your Brock Campus ID which you will need to access the Experience Profile. The final date to submit the profile is on December 10, 2021.

Step 5: Next Steps

- Thank you for submitting your application! You will receive an email from Ontario Universities Application Centre (OUAC) shortly after submission of your application. We encourage all applicants to check their student portal periodically for any important updates or if any other required documentation is to be provided.
