Change of Major Application Requirements – 2017-2018

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Department of Kinesiology reviews Change of Major applications once a year in the spring after the completion of the most recent Fall/Winter academic year.

- Declare/Change of Major forms are available through the Office of the Registrar and must be submitted
 to the Department of Kinesiology no later than the deadline stated below. Please visit and refer to
 www.brocku.ca/registrar/forms to obtain a Declare/Change of Major form. There is no separate
 application form and no additional documentation (e.g. references, personal letters) will be considered
 by the Department.
- The BPhEd, BKin, and BSc(Kin) programs are in high demand and are limited enrolment programs. On this basis, <u>admission is competitive</u> and the Department of Kinesiology cannot guarantee admission to any of our programs. As such, interested students are advised to continue in an alternate area of study and consult regularly with an Academic Advisor in their current program/Department or through the Office of the Registrar (www.brocku.ca/registrar/advising) until they have been notified by the Department of Kinesiology of the outcome of their application. The Department will strive to notify all applicants of the outcome of their application before registration opens for Fall/Winter courses for the following academic year so that students can make appropriate course selections.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: May 10, 2018

MINIMUM APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

In order for a current Brock student to be eligible to apply to the BPhEd, BKin or BSc(Kin) program, the following minimum application requirements must first be met:

1. At the time of submitting a Declare/Change Major form for acceptance to the Department of Kinesiology, the following courses must be in progress or have been completed, and the following minimum final grades must have been achieved:

Bachelor of Physical Education	Bachelor of Kinesiology or BSc Kinesiology
KINE 1P90 – minimum final grade of 65%	KINE 1P90 – minimum final grade of 65%
KINE 1P93 – minimum final grade of 65%	KINE 1P98 – minimum final grade of 65%
BIOL 1F90 – minimum final grade of 50%	BIOL 1F90 – minimum final grade of 50%

- 2. The applicant's <u>overall average cannot be less than a 60%</u>, and any student currently on Academic Probation or Academic Suspension will not be considered.
- 3. Students must be applying into second year or third year of the program, the department will not consider applications into the fourth year of the program.

Due to the programs having limited spaces open each year for students wishing to change their major, students are advised that the above outlined requirements are <u>minimum application requirements</u>. Having achieved these requirements will ensure that your application is considered, however <u>meeting the minimum application</u> requirements DOES NOT guarantee acceptance to the BPhEd, BKin, or BSc(Kin) program. The application process is competitive based on the number of seats available and the number of students applying to each program in the Department.
