Students wishing to proceed to year 2 as a BKin or BSc (Kin) major must have achieved a minimum 65 percent major average, a minimum of 65 percent in KINE 1P90 and KINE 1P88, a minimum 60 percent non-major average, and a minimum 60 percent overall average. Students wishing to proceed to year 3 and 4 as either a BKin or BSc (Kin) major must have achieved a minimum 60 percent major average, a minimum 60 percent non-major average and a minimum of 60 percent overall average. Students not meeting the above requirements will be listed as majors in the Bachelor of Applied Health (AGEN).
