Program Notes

1.	Students wishing to proceed to year 2 as a BKin or BSc (Kin) major must have achieved a minimum 65 percent major average, a minimum of 65 percent in KINE 1P90 and 1P88, a minimum 60 percent non-major average, and a minimum 60 percent overall average. Students wishing to proceed to year 3 and 4 as either a BKin or BSc (Kin) major must have achieved a minimum 60 percent major average, a minimum 60 percent non-major average and a minimum of 60 percent overall average. Students not meeting the above requirements will be listed as majors in the Bachelor of Applied Health (AGEN). See Academic Regulations regarding repeating courses.
2.	BKin and BSc (Kin) majors must take a minimum of one elective credit outside the Department of Kinesiology.
3.	BSc (Kin) majors must take a minimum of 2.5 elective science credits.
4.	BKin and BSc (Kin) majors are required to have current emergency First Aid/CPR certification upon application to graduate.
5.	The following courses are available for Science credit: KINE 1P90, 1P98, 1P99, 2P05, 2P09, 2P90, 3P05, 3P10, 3P90, 3P92, 3P94, 3P97, 3P98, 4P01, 4P05, 4P08, 4P09, 4P10, 4P80, 4P84, 4P94, 4P97, 4P98.
6.	The following courses are not available for Science credit: ASTR 1P01, 1P02, BIOL 1F25, 1P23, 1P24, 1P27, 1P28, 2P97, CHEM 1P00, ERSC 1P92, 1P94, 2P08, MATH 1P20, 1P70, PHYS 1P21, 1P22, SCIE 1P50, 1P51, 1P52.
7.	The following courses are considered experiential learning: KINE 1P90, 1P93, 1P98, 2F00, 2P02, 2P05, 2P90, 2P92, 3P00, 3P02, 3P03, 3P05, 3P06, 3P08, 3P10, 3P13, 3P14, 3P22, 3P32, 3P80, 3P90, 3P91, 3P94, 3P98, 4F16, 4F91, 4P00, 4P01, 4P02, 4P09, 4P10, 4P12, 4P13, 4P14, 4P16, 4P22, 4P32, 4P80, 4P82, 4P91, 4P93, 4P94, 4P86, 4P87, 4P88 and 4P89.
8.	Students can only hold 1.0 credit from KINE 4P86, 4P87, 4P88, 4P89.
9.	In 20 credit degree programs a maximum of eight credits may be numbered 1(alpha)00 to 1(alpha)99; at least three credits must be numbered 2(alpha)90 or above; at least three credits must be numbered 3(alpha)90 or above; and the remaining credits must be numbered 2(alpha)00 or above. In some circumstances, in order to meet university degree and program requirements, more than 20 credits may be taken.
