Overview

Research Focus. I am a tenured Professor of Epidemiology in the Department of Public Health Sciences, Queen's University, and an Adjunct Professor in the College of Medicine, University of Saskatchewan. During my career I have pursued a progressive series of research foci: 1) injury and violence prevention; 2) injury and illness in rural and farm populations; and 3) health and its social determinants in adolescent populations, with a primary focus on pediatric violence and injury. Using public health surveillance, analytical and experimental epidemiology, and mixed methods approaches, this work has provided critical insight for policy/health promotion initiatives in Canada, the US and Europe.

Publications and Productivity: I have 293 published peer-review publications, which have collectively been cited >16,000 times (H-Index 61). In the last 25 years I have: 1) co-led a national adolescent health study (Health Behaviour in School-aged Children) affiliated with the World Health Organization and funded in Canada by the Public Health Agency of Canada; 2) led a major CIHR-funded cohort study examining the health of rural populations in Saskatchewan; 3) co-led the development of a national farm injury surveillance program; 4) been the nominated principal investigator of 12 tri-council and 9 other competitive grants; been co-investigator on 19 tri-council, 6 NIH(CDC/NIOSH) and 11 other competitive grants; and conducted an additional 30 research contracts with federal, provincial and other agencies.

Expertise: I have extensive training and experience in epidemiological research methods and associated quantitative analyses, including: descriptive epidemiology, public health surveillance, cross-sectional studies, population health surveys, case-control studies, cohort studies, randomized controlled trials, systematic reviews and meta-analyses, mixed methods, categorical analyses, applied regression, multi-level modelling, and causal inference.

Teaching and Supervision. I have introduced and taught introductory courses in epidemiological methods to undergraduate and medical students. I have taught graduate (MSc, MPH, PhD) in a range of courses from introductory through advanced epidemiology. During my career I received the departmental teaching award 3 times, and was nominated for a university-wide graduate supervision award 3 times. I have mentored >100 students, residents, and post-doctoral fellows, with 20 now holding academic positions, including two Canada Research Chairs.

Leadership: As my career has evolved over the last 25 years, my past administrative roles have evolved from medical teaching coordination, and MSc and PhD coordination with my department at Queen's University, to Department Head (2013-2018). As Head, I served on senior faculty committees and supervised 17 faculty, 120 students, and 5 staff. I run an active "dry" lab, with a typical complement of 5-10 trainees.
