

Graduate Employment Survey

Employment Outcomes of 2010 Graduates of Brock Undergraduate Programs

Each year, graduates of undergraduate programs of Ontario universities are surveyed to determine certain employment outcomes. The most recent survey was conducted during the 2012-13 academic year and was directed to students who graduated in 2010. The survey, conducted by CCI Research Inc. on behalf of the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities, includes employment experiences, earnings, and skills of students six months and two years after they have completed their degrees. What follows is a brief summary of some of the results.

Employment Rates

- Six months after graduation:

Ontario	86.5%
Brock University	87.7%
- Two years after graduation:

Ontario	92.2%
Brock University	92.8%

Skills Match

- Six months after graduation, per cent of respondents who considered their work either “closely” or “somewhat” related to their university education:

Ontario	73%
Brock University	70%
- Two years after graduation, per cent of respondents who considered their work either “closely” or “somewhat” related to their university education:

Ontario	80%
Brock University	82%

Survey Response Rates

- Ontario: 70,845 graduates were surveyed and 25,583 (**36.1%**) responded.
- Brock University: 2,982 graduates were surveyed and 1,035 (**34.7%**) responded.
