A concentration in information systems provides you with the knowledge and skills needed to analyze business processes and identify ways to improve those processes through innovative application of information technologies. Management Information Systems examines the use, management, and impact of information technologies on businesses and consumers.

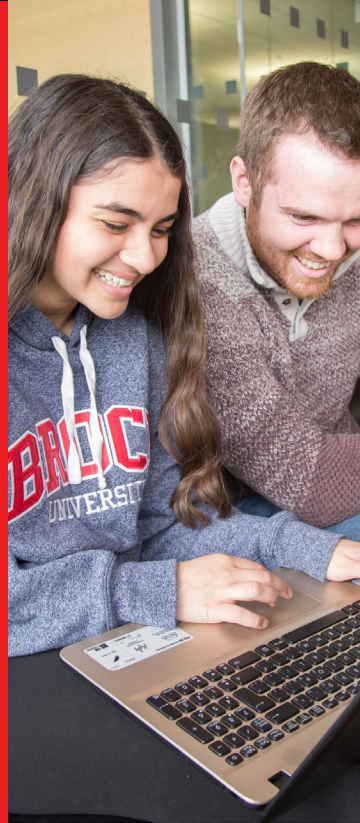
Business Process Analysis
Analysts determine and develop application solutions to maximize business processes. There are many areas of specialization, including feasibility analysis, web design, process or data modeling, change management, training, and process design.

Consulting
Consultants work with client organizations to enhance organizational performance through the application of process change and information systems. They develop and manage a wide range of projects such as optimizing the IT infrastructure and applications. Many consulting firms also offer technology outsourcing for clients.

Project Management
Project managers manage a team of people who are engaged in systems development, maintenance and/or implementation for major applications. Entry-level positions include junior project manager or a project administrator on a large project.

Client Services Support
Service Support have a variety of different responsibilities such as upgrading software, replacing hardware, system set up for new employees, providing user support, performing virus scans, etc. They may work with servers, networks or storage, which may require learning new operating systems or software and acquiring new certifications.

Software
Working with software includes building databases, interfaces, and applications that support business processes. MIS graduates, especially those with courses in Computer Science, may start as junior programmers. Eventually, they may become a senior software developer which involves designing and writing new software.
