



BACHELOR OF EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION (ONLINE)

Recognizing the strong foundation gained through a two-year Early Childhood Education Diploma (ECE), the online Honours Bachelor of Early Childhood Education (BECE) program extends and deepens your capacity to support children's learning and development and enhance your career pathway. As a BECE student, you'll be prepared to become an innovative practitioner, leader and advocate for children, their families and communities. You will also gain the foundation to pursue further studies, including teacher education programs and graduate studies.

PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

The online BECE program is comprehensive, addressing all developmental domains, including physical health and well-being, social competence, emotional maturity, language and cognitive development and communication skills. With a holistic vision of child development, the program sees children as being part of a whole community that includes their family, culture and natural environment. The following program framework illustrates the program's integrated focus areas and philosophy. Ethical standards and standards of practice for the teaching profession are explicitly and intentionally integrated into the BECE framework.

ADMISSIONS CONSIDERATIONS

TRANSFER CREDIT GUIDELINES

- Generally, 7 out of 20 credits are granted for applicants meeting the criteria below
- Applicants who present additional post-secondary credentials beyond the ECE diploma may be assessed for further transfer credits up to a maximum of 10.0 credits
- Brock offers on-the-spot admissions for students transferring ECE diploma credits (see discover.brocku.ca/transfer-students for details)

MINIMUM CREDENTIALS FOR ADMISSION

- A COMPLETED two-year Early Childhood Education Diploma (ECE), or equivalent, with a grade of 'B' (normally a calculated average of no less than 75 per cent based on all credits completed within the ECE diploma program, excluding practicum grades)
- Any additional education credentials submitted as part of the application will be assessed by the Admissions Office and taken into consideration.

PROGRAM & ADMISSIONS NOTES

International Students: When applying for your study permit you will also need to include the co-op work permit application in order to participate in internships. Contact foeipo@brocku.ca with questions about immigration and being an international BECE student.
