PROGRAMS AT A GLANCE

PRIMARY/JUNIOR (GRADES K-6)

Bachelor of Arts Child and Youth Studies (Honours)/Bachelor of Education* - A multidisciplinary program offering a broadbased approach towards children and youth within the context of family, school, peer groups and community.

JUNIOR/INTERMEDIATE (GRADES 4-10, EMPHASIZING ELEMENTARY SCHOOL)

Bachelor of Arts Integrated Studies (Honours)/Bachelor of Education* - Choose one teachable subject: Dramatic Arts, English, French (second language), Geography, History, Mathematics, Music (vocal), Visual Arts or Science – General.

Bachelor of Science Integrated Studies (Honours)/Bachelor of Education* - Choose one teachable subject: Geography, Mathematics or Science – General.

Bachelor of Physical Education (Honours)/Bachelor of Education* - Teachable subject: Health and Physical Education.

Bachelor of Arts Interactive Arts and Science (Honours)/Bachelor of Education* - Learn to integrate digital technologies into the classroom such as interactive media, including makerspaces, AR, 3D modelling/ printing, video games and more. Choose one teachable subject: Dramatic Arts, English, French (second language), Geography, History, Mathematics, Music (vocal), Science — General or Visual Arts.

INTERMEDIATE/SENIOR (GRADES 7-12)

Bachelor of Arts (Honours)/Bachelor of Education - Choose one major/first teachable subject: Dramatic Arts, English, French (second language), Geography, History or Visual Arts. Second teachable subject declared after Year 1.

Bachelor of Science (Honours)/Bachelor of Education: Choose one major/first teachable subject: Biological Sciences, Chemistry, Geography, Mathematics or Physics. Second teachable subject declared after Year 1.

Bachelor of Physical Education (Honours)/Bachelor of Education: Major/first teachable subject: Health and Physical Education. Second teachable subject declared after Year 1.

**P/J and J/I students are required to complete 4U, 4M or university level courses in English, Mathematics, Science, Canadian Geography and Canadian History (or similar approved courses that reflect Canadian content) prior to entering the fifth year of the Concurrent Teacher Education program.*
