## EDUCATIONAL INTERNSHIP EDUC 5P96

Students may take **one** internship course during their program. The internship provides a one-term duration field placement experience that allows students work with a field mentor. In addition to focused fieldwork, students are expected to write a reflective analytical report and conduct a critical self-performance evaluation. The field experience allows students to apply theory to practice and vice versa. The student is expected to meet with a faculty supervisor on a regular basis. Students must find their own field placement.

Students may take either an Independent Study or an Internship. This course should not involve students in research with human participants (which would require Research Ethics Board approval).

The proposal must be approved by the Graduate Program Director in order for students to be given an override that allows them to register for the course. Please allow up to 5 business days for processing.
