HOW TO PAY THE DEPOSIT:

- 1) The deposit is due as noted on the Letter of Admission.
- 2) See complete instructions to make payments: <u>https://brocku.ca/safa/tuition-and-fees/making-a-payment/</u>
- 3) The receipt provided by CIBC or Convera is suitable to include with your study permit application.
- 4) After initiating the deposit, check the *Finance History* on the mybrock account to confirm credit to the student account. It may take four to five business days for this to occur. A receipt can also be printed using the icon on the top right-hand side of the page.

DEPOSIT REFUND POLICY:

- Deposit will be refunded to the PAYER if a student is not granted a Student Authorization (Permit) to study in Canada. All requests for these refunds should emailed to <u>susan.virtue@brocku.ca</u> and accompanied by a copy of the IRCC letter of rejection.
- 2) Deposit will also be refunded if requested 90 days or more before the start date of the program (as indicated on the Letter of Admission).
- 3) Deposit will not be refundable or transferable once a Brock University offer of admission has been used to successfully obtain a Student Authorization (visa) to study in Canada.
- 4) Deposits paid above the minimum deposit amount of \$3,000 will be fully refunded.
- 5) Once a student has registered for classes and the term begins, the deposit is applied towards tuition and the Tuition Refund Policy applies.

TUITION REFUND POLICY:

- 1) Tuition fee refunds follow the *Student Accounts & Financial Aid* schedule posted at: <u>https://brocku.ca/safa/drops-withdrawals-and-refunds/</u>.
- 2) Any outstanding balance on a student account will be deducted from the refund by *Student Accounts & Financial Aid*.
