

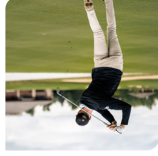

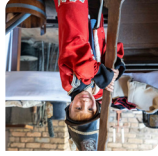

Niagara Parks is home to three of Southern Ontario's most scenic and top-rated championship courses.



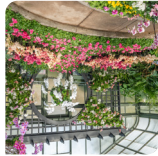

Grab a seat on the closest rooftop patio to the Falls. Savour shareable gourmet dishes, local craft beers and VQA wines.

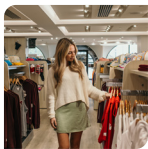


Table Rock Market + Shop

At the base of the Zipline to the Falls attraction.

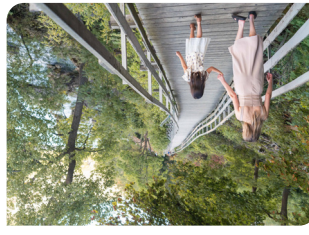

10 WHITE WATER WALK

Enjoy the raw power of the Niagara River and its Class 6 rapids from the safety of a quarter-mile boardwalk.

Walk among 2000 free-flying butterflies in a tropical oasis with trickling waterfalls and lush greenery.



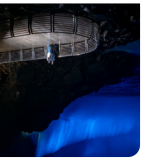
9 WHIRLPOOL AERO CAR

POWER STATION AT NIGHT
Experience an immersive sound and light show and then follow the LED lights through the 180-foot-deep underground tunnel for a stunning illuminated view of the Horseshoe Falls.



14 NIAGARA PARKS POWER STATION + TUNNEL

Uncover the history of Niagara's power as you walk through a 2,200-foot-long tunnel leading to an observation deck at the base of Niagara Falls. Feel the electric energy in the generator hall, complete with a bilingual audio tour and an educational Nikola Tesla exhibit.



13 JOURNEY BEHIND THE FALLS

Descend 125 feet through ancient bedrock and explore 130-year-old tunnels for an up-close encounter with the mighty Horseshoe Falls.



Pack your bags and prepare for the adventure of a lifetime! This fully-immersive, flying theatre ride takes you on an awe-inspiring journey from Lake Ontario to Lake Erie, with views like never before. You'll soar over 56 kilometres of parkland and swirling rapids, glide past steep rock faces and lush forests, and travel through dramatic battles that changed the course of history, all before getting a heart-pounding perspective over the edge of Niagara Falls.

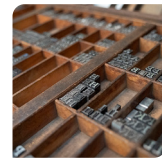
HERITAGE + LEGACY

Learn the secrets behind the original text message! Discover 500 years of history inside the home of Toronto's first mayor and rebel publisher, William Lyon Mackenzie.

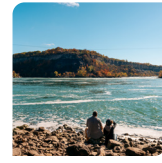


4 Landscape of Nations

Enhance your experience by taking the free self-guided audio tour, *Rekindling All Our Relations*, available on Google Play and the App Store.

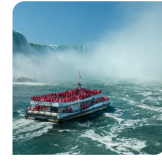


16 Dufferin Islands
This pristine nature area consists of several quiet, secluded islands connected by footbridges and trails. Popular with hikers, birders and picnic enthusiasts.

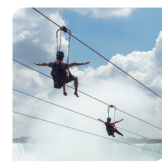


5 Floral Clock

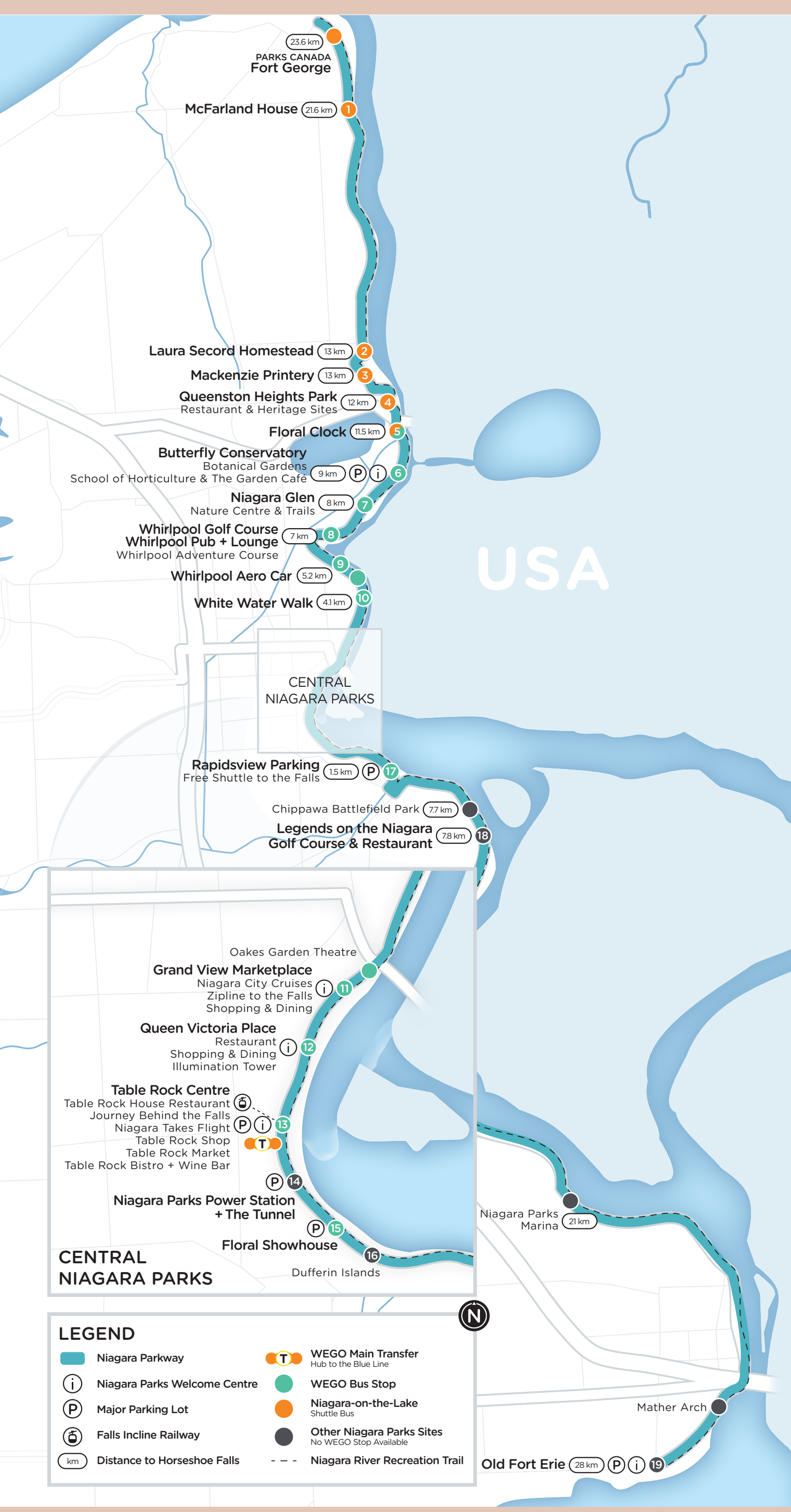
