

CURRENT GOODMAN BACC APPLICANTS

Goodman's BAcc-MAcc pathway is accredited by CPA Ontario. Goodman's BAcc/MAcc CPA pathway will allow you to complete all the required courses and modules for the CPA designation. Upon graduation from the MAcc program, you will proceed directly to the Common Final Exam (CFE). The MAcc program covers all four CPA elective modules, plus Capstones 1 and 2.

NON-GOODMAN APPLICANTS

Applicants who did not complete Goodman's BAcc program should consult with the Graduate Programs Office to determine eligibility for the MAcc CPA pathway. Applicants must have completed a four-year bachelor's degree in accounting, in Canada, that fulfills the equivalent CPA Ontario 51 credit hour prerequisites*. To determine your eligibility, please reach out to our admissions committee through the Goodman Graduate Portal at portal.bus.brocku.ca

*Please note that the 51 credit hour prerequisites exceed the PEP entry requirements.

ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

Dean of Graduate Studies Entrance Scholarships are worth \$1,000 and are awarded to full-time domestic and international students admitted to the MAcc program with an admission average of 82% or higher at the time of admission.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND ADMISSION PROCESS

MINIMUM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Four-year Goodman bachelor's degree in accounting (BAcc) or a Canadian bachelor's degree in accounting that fulfills the equivalent prerequisites
- B/75 per cent academic average in last two years of undergraduate study
- B/75 per cent academic average in key accounting courses with no grade below 60 per cent
- Minimum English Language Proficiency score (if applicable):
 - TOEFL: IBT 105
 - Academic IELTS: 7.5

APPLICATION DEADLINE FOR JANUARY START

The application review begins February 1 of each year and applications will be reviewed until the program is full. We encourage you to apply early, due to the competitive nature of the program.

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

All documents must be submitted electronically.

- Online OUAC application
- Application fee
- Scanned original transcripts from all post-secondary institutions
- Two academic references provided by accounting faculty members
- Statement of interest
- Resumé
- Scanned official TOEFL, IELTS or equivalent score (if applicable)
