CURRICULUM

Our focus is on helping you develop and integrate broad-based, functional business knowledge needed for career advancement. The program is comprised of five of the required credits in our Master of Business Administration degree, which includes at least one course from the main areas of business.

FEES

TUITION

You will be charged tuition on a per course basis. Each 5PXX course is equal to one half (0.5) credit. Full-time students take one year (two semesters) to complete the program. Part-time students are assumed to be studying for two years (six semesters).

Living expenses and books are extra. We recommend that you budget approximately \$9,000–\$12,000 (per year) for living expenses and books, depending on your lifestyle.

Tuition and student fees are due at the beginning of each semester. The fees provided are approximate and are intended as an estimate only. For more information, visit:

TRANSFERRING TO THE MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM

If you achieve a final overall average of 75%, you may transfer directly to the Master of Business Administration (MBA) with the approval of the Goodman Graduate Programs Office.

If you opt to transfer to the MBA, you will not receive or will relinquish the Graduate Diploma in Business Administration and instead may use the credits earned in the Diploma to fulfill half of the MBA degree requirements.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission is extremely competitive, and we take all aspects of your application into consideration.

In addition to our minimum admission requirements, we also consider academic ability, professional and leadership experience, and future potential for achievement and success in the business world.

MINIMUM REOUIREMENTS

- · Four year bachelor's degree (Canadian equivalent) from an accredited university
- B/75 per cent minimum academic average in last two years of study (Canadian equivalent)
- GMAT score of at least 550 or a minimum GRE score in the 60th percentile
 - ▶ GMAT/GRE waivers will be considered if you have completed an undergraduate or graduate degree from a Canadian or American university in the last seven years with an overall average of A- (80% or 3.67 GPA) or higher.
- Minimum English Language Proficiency Score:
 - ▶ TOEFL IBT: 105 /Academic IELTS: 7.5 / Pearson Test of English (Academic): 72
 - ▶ If you're not sure if you need this, contact us through **portal.bus.brocku.ca** for an assessment.
 - ▶ We may request an English Language score from any applicant whose first language is not English.
- · Work experience is preferred but is not required.



Applicants that do not meet one of the above noted criteria may be considered on an exceptional
basis if they possess a minimum of seven years of significant full-time managerial work experience
(as determined by the admissions committee). Candidates who are admitted based on work
experience will be placed on probation and will be required to achieve a minimum grade of 70%
in each of their first 5 courses in order to proceed in the program.

APPLY NOW

There is no set deadline for Graduate Diploma in Business Administration applications.

Admissions are processed on a rolling basis and applications are reviewed as they are received.

You are encouraged to apply at least four months before the start of your desired entry point to allow for necessary processing time.

FULL-TIME STUDENTS

- Program length: two terms (one year)
- Start in September or January

PART-TIME STUDENTS

- Typical program length: six terms (two years)
- · Start in September, January or April

Application review can take up to one month from when we receive a completed application. Admission decisions will be posted to your **my.brocku.ca** account as well as emailed to you.

CONTACT US FOR A PRE-ASSESSMENT

We strongly recommend that you request a pre-assessment of your eligibility on the Graduate Portal at **portal.bus.brocku.ca** before you apply to confirm that you meet the requirements and that your application would be competitive.
