Notice: Recruitment and Appointment Process for the Associate Vice President, International

To: Members of the Brock University Graduate Students' Association (GSA)

Pursuant to the GSA Policy (Document 27A) and other relevant GSA legislation, the association is looking to fill the role of Associate Vice-President, International. The appointment will take effect for November 7, 2022 and be in effect until April 30, 2023. The start date may alter, dependent on recruitment results. Recruitment will be rolling, whereby consideration of candidates will begin immediately, with a deadline for applications of October 28, 2022, at 4pm EST.

Applications must include the following:

- i. A statement of interest in the position/cover letter
- ii. A resume/curriculum vitae highlighting relevant experience
- iii. Contact information for three references.

Additionally, experience of the international graduate student context is considered an asset. Interviews shall be scheduled and conducted during the week following the close of the application period with an aim to announce an appointment in the week prior to the position commencement date. This is a volunteer position.
