Notice: Recruitment and Appointment Process for the Associate Vice-President, International 2021

To: All Interested Applicants and Members of the Brock University Graduate Students' Association (GSA)

Pursuant to the GSA Policy (Document 27A) and other relevant GSA legislation, the association is looking to fill the role of Associate Vice-President, International. The appointment will take effect for August 9th, 2021 and be until April 30th, 2022. Recruitment will be rolling, whereby consideration of candidates will begin immediately, with a deadline for applications of July 26th, 2021, at 4:00pm. Applications must include the following:

 - ii. a resume/curriculum vitae highlighting relevant experience

Additionally, experience of the international graduate student context is considered an asset. Interviews shall be scheduled and conducted during the week following the close of the application period with an aim to announce an appointment in the week prior to the position commencement date. This is a volunteer position.
