Executive Reports

President

- Will be having videos with the Dean, one with spots on Campus, another on a bike tour of Niagara
- Will be having monthly townhalls with the Dean of FGS to update students on what the GSA and FGS is doing for students, starting August 19, that will be advertised by both FGS and VP of Communications
- FGS is developing an infographic to differentiate between FGS and GSA
- Will be speaking to the Provost if there are reduced TA positions
- Has had a conversation with the Dean of FGS to discuss the increase in support from supervisors and PIs
- Only 40% of FMS have been allowed back into their labs, this is much lower in health sciences, which seems to be a two part issue of either PIs not applying or students not asking their PIs to apply
- Addressing why a Goodman class was cancelled as it has a direct impact on the necessity of it for international graduate students and specialization in finance
 - o This has since been reinstated
- Barb will return on Monday, Mary will officially start training the following Monday
- Will be looking at including home coverage health and dental insurance coverage and trialling it in September
- The GSA is looking at a new physical space on campus, still no immediate possibility for a graduate student bar
- The Zone is still being built and improved on
- Need to host a board meeting and AGM (delayed from April due to COVID) in the fall and need to look at platforms and how to run them with so many students
 - o Will be sending out bylaw drafts to be reviewed at next meeting

Vice-President, Equity and External

- Has endorsed the Education for All, specifically more grants and less loans
- Attended CFS educational workshops
