Notice: Recruitment and Appointment Process for the Vice-President, Student Engagement – Fall 2021

To: All Interested and Qualified Members of the Brock University Graduate Students' Association (GSA)

The Board of Directors of the Graduate Students' Association is moving forward with filling a vacancy in the role of Vice-president, Student Engagement. Pursuant to the GSA Bylaw (Document 001) and other relevant GSA legislation, the Association will undertake a recruitment process to fill this vacancy. The anticipated appointment start date is October 1st, 2021 and will be until April 30th, 2022. Recruitment will be rolling, whereby consideration of candidates will begin immediately, with a deadline for applications of September 17th, 2021 at 4:00pm EST. Applications must include the following:

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- i. a statement of interest in the position/cover letter,
 - ii. a resume/curriculum vitae highlighting relevant experience
 - iii. indication of ability to provide, or direct contact information for three references.
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Interviews shall be scheduled and conducted on an ongoing basis throughout the application period with an aim to announce an appointment immediately following approval from the Board.
