Packing checklist

What to bring and what to leave at home while living in Semi-Suite and Traditional Style Residences (DeCew, Vallee, Earp, Residence 8 and Lowenberger)







What should you bring?

Bed Linen, comforter, and pillow for a single bed

Plastic, metal, or vinyl organizational furnishings (see <u>Allowable Furnishings</u>)

Clothes hangers

Mini fridge (max. 5 cubic feet) with no separate freezer compartment (see Allowable Appliances)

Reusable mug and water bottle

Fan with no heater component

Desk/reading lamp

Laundry bag/bin

Detergent and dryer sheets

Towels and face cloth

Bathrobe and shower caddy

Washroom cleaning supplies (except for DeCew residents whose washrooms are cleaned by our custodial team)

A few plates, cups, and cutlery for snacks

Dish soap and dishtowels

Bedroom cleaning supplies (all-purpose cleaner, cleaning cloth, duster, garbage bags, etc.)

Chargers and cables for electronics

CSA or UL approved surge protected power bar

Student card (if you already have it)

Headphones or earplugs

Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo/conditioner, deodorant, sunscreen, etc.)

Whiteboard/message board

Lightweight room decorations

First aid supplies

General Health Related Recommendations

Personal protective equipment (face masks, hand soap/sanitizer, gloves.)

Disinfectant supplies

Personal documents (health card, photo ID, etc.)





What should you leave at home?

- S Furnishings that are not allowed as per Allowable Furnishings
- Bed risers
- Mattresses
- Mattress pads or toppers thicker than 3"
- Ethernet cables (there is only Wi-Fi)
- Candles, incense, or wax/oil lamps
- Pets (not even as visitors)
- Eridges larger than 5 cubic feet or with a separate freezer compartment (see Allowable Appliances)
- Space heaters
- Beer or beer-type beverages (malt liquor etc.) in any type of glass bottle
- Large-volume alcohol containers (kegs, "bubbas", Texas Mickeys, etc.)
- Alcohol paraphernalia (funnels, beer pong tables, etc.)
- Ashtrays (all residences are non-smoking)
- Room alteration/repair supplies (paint, nails, window treatments, putty, etc.)
- Adhesive materials for room decorations (scotch tape, 3M hooks, sticky tack, etc.)
- Weapons, simulated weapons, or anything that could cause harm or be seen as intimidating
- Anything illegal (illegal drugs, etc.)
- Orug paraphernalia (pipes, hookahs, bongs, etc.)
- Sub woofers and amps are not recommended due to noise restrictions
- LED light strips (only permitted if hung using) double-sided sticky pads provided by residence)
