## What to Bring / What Not to Bring

- ✓ Mattress
- ✓ Zippered mattress protector
- ✓ Desk
- ✓ Chair
- ✓ Dresser
- ✓ Bookshelves
- ✓ File drawer or desk drawers
- ✓ Small bedroom garbage can
- ✓ Small bedroom recycling bin
- ✓ Closet space or wardrobe
- ✓ Window coverings or blinds
- ✓ Double-sided sticky pads for room decorations
- ✓ Telephone handset (in living room for unit)
- ✓ Wireless internet
- ✓ Basic cable (in living room only)
- ✓ Kitchen table and chairs
- ✓ Oven/stove (excluding Court 9)
- ✓ Microwave
- ✓ Full-sized fridge with freezer component
- ✓ Large kitchen garbage can
- ✓ Living room couch, chair, and end table(s)
- ✓ Shower curtain
- ✓ Plunger
- ✓ Washroom garbage cans
- ✓ Central Vacuum (Village only)
- ✓ 2 Large blue recycling bins
- ✓ 1 Large grey recycling bin
- ✓ Snow shovel
- ✓ Fire extinguisher

### WHAT TO BRING

- ❑ Bed Linen, comforter, and pillow for a single bed
- ❑ Plastic, metal, or vinyl organizational furnishings (see [Allowable Furnishings](#))
- ❑ Clothes hangers
- ❑ Mini fridge (max. 5 cubic feet) with no separate freezer compartment (see [Allowable Appliances](#))
- ❑ Fan with no heater component
- ❑ Laundry bag/bin
- ❑ Detergent and dryer sheets
- ❑ Towels and face cloth
- ❑ Bathrobe and shower caddy
- ❑ Pots, pans, dishes, and cutlery
- ❑ Dish soap, dishtowels, and dish rack
- ❑ Small kitchen appliances (coffee maker, toaster, kettle, etc. See [Allowable Appliances](#))
- ❑ A TV for the living room (bring your own coaxial cable/cord)
- ❑ Cleaning supplies for kitchen, washroom, bedroom, etc. (all-purpose cleaner, toilet cleaner, sponges, gloves, mop and bucket, floor cleaner, etc.)
- ❑ Vacuum (Village has central vacuum)
- ❑ Garbage and recycling bags
- ❑ Desk/reading lamp
- ❑ Chargers and cables for electronics
- ❑ CSA or UL approved surge protected power bar
- ❑ Student card (if you already have it)
- ❑ Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo /conditioner, deodorant, sunscreen, etc.)
- ❑ Reusable mug and water bottle
- ❑ Headphones and/or earplugs
- ❑ Whiteboard/message board
- ❑ Lightweight room decorations
- ❑ First aid supplies

#### General Health Related Recommendations:

- ❑ Personal protective equipment (face masks, hand soap/sanitizer, gloves.)
- ❑ Disinfectant supplies
- ❑ Personal documents (health card, photo ID, etc.)

### WHAT NOT TO BRING

- ✗ Furnishings that are not allowed as per [Allowable Furnishings](#)
- ✗ Bed risers
- ✗ Mattresses not provided by Brock
- ✗ Mattress pads or toppers thicker than 3"
- ✗ Ethernet cables (there is only Wi-Fi)
- ✗ Candles, incense, or wax/oil lamps
- ✗ Pets (not even as visitors)
- ✗ Fridges larger than 5 cubic feet or with a separate freezer compartment (see [Allowable Appliances](#))
- ✗ Space heaters
- ✗ Beer or beer-type beverages (malt liquor etc.) in any type of glass bottle
- ✗ Large-volume alcohol containers (kegs, "bubbys", Texas Miceys, etc.)
- ✗ Alcohol paraphernalia (funnels, beer pong tables, etc.)
- ✗ Ashtrays (all residences are non-smoking)
- ✗ Room alteration/repair supplies (paint, nails, window treatments, putty, etc.)
- ✗ Adhesive materials for room decorations (scotch tape, 3m hooks, sticky tack, etc.)
- ✗ Weapons, simulated weapons, or anything that could cause harm or be seen as intimidating
- ✗ Anything illegal (illegal drugs, etc.)
- ✗ Drug paraphernalia (pipes, hookahs, bongs, etc.)
- ✗ Sub woofers and amps are not recommended due to noise restrictions
- ✗ LED light strips (only permitted if hung using double-sided sticky pads provided by residence)
