This action can look like many different things: environmental work, anti-oppression work, self-education on decolonial methods and ideologies, attending protests, signing petitions, supporting indigenous businesses, the list goes on. So, while it is important to say a Land Acknowledgement, take the time to truly listen and think about what is means, what is being said, and what is being asked. Lastly, I ask you how can we as a country, community, or university take the words from this Land Acknowledgment and create positive action?
