The Centre for Canadian Studies at Brock University invites paper submissions or panel proposals on the theme "Rural Canada."

This interdisciplinary conference will examine the world between the cities and the wilderness, those liminal spaces, and the people, culture, politics, and issues of concern within them.

This call is open to all disciplines, and the only limiting factor is that the paper must be on Canadian topics, broadly construed (geographically, thematically, regionally, etc.).

Sessions will be held at Brock University

Topics can include, but need not be restricted to, the following themes:

- Immigration in rural Canada
- Indigenous communities in rural Canada
- Canada's rural politics
- Socializing in rural Canada
- Health care in rural Canada
- History of rural spaces in Canada
- Rural-urban tensions

Submissions should include an abstract of no more than 250 words and a 1-page CV identifying institutional affiliation and key scholarly contributions.
