Cover letter:

- Please indicate your name, student number, and contact information (mailing address, phone, email)
- Status at Brock (e.g. major, year of study)
- Number of years you have been working on creative writing
- Any previous creative writing workshops, courses, publications etc.
- Statement of personal goals for the course (e.g. Why would you like to take this course? What do you hope to achieve?)

All applicants will be notified about the status of their application in early-August. **Students are advised to register in an alternate course** in case their application to ENCW 3P08 is not successful.
