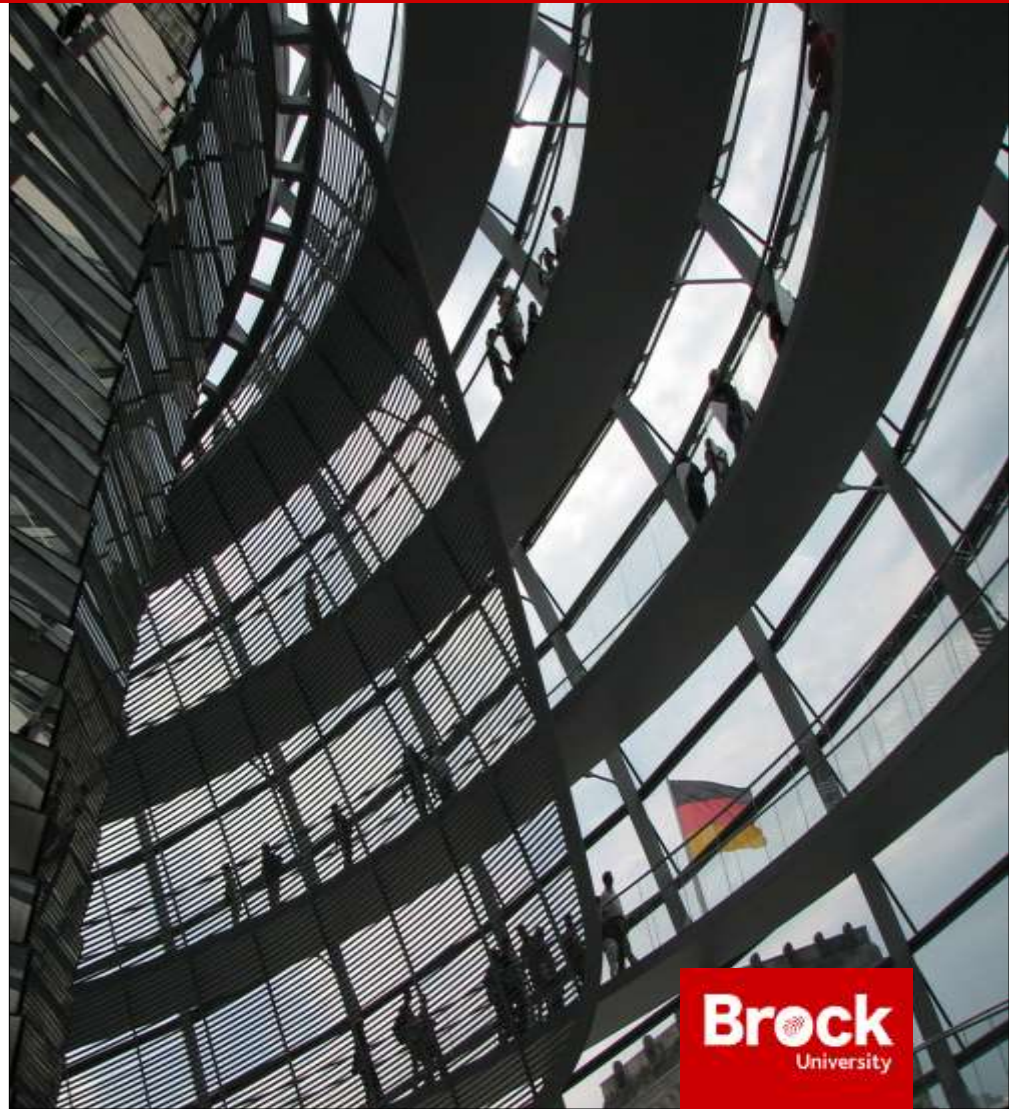

French Studies - Study/Work Abroad Opportunities

- Ontario-Rhône-Alpes Student Exchange
- NEOMA: Exchange with France for Dual-Degree Students in the Goodman School of Business
- many students go on exchange to France or Quebec
- Work abroad for three to four months in the summer. Positions range from the hospitality industry to office work. Participants come from universities across Canada.



Hispanic and Latin American Studies - Study/Work Abroad Opportunities



Students can experience Hispanic and Iberian languages (Spanish and Portuguese), and cultures by immersing in study-abroad programs in a Spanish-Portuguese speaking countries. Brock has study exchange agreements and partnerships with many universities in Spain and Portugal, as well as Central and South America. In addition, our students have studied at the University of Alcala and the University of Salamanca (Spain), for one month or multiple months in the spring/summer or throughout the academic year.

Overseas teaching opportunities - Brock International offers extensive information for work opportunities abroad.

Students may also participate with one of the Brock's exchange partners in Spain (ex: university of Alfonso El Sabio); be a Teaching Assistant in Spain (program through Embassy of Spain in Ottawa), and take part in internships in Portugal, Spain, Central and South America (see [https://www.gooverseas.com/program-search/intern?f\[0\]=location:167&f\[1\]=location:333](https://www.gooverseas.com/program-search/intern?f[0]=location:167&f[1]=location:333))

Italian Studies - Study/Work Abroad Opportunities

- Summer Studies Program in Italy, for both Majors and non-Majors - **ITAL 3M50- Reading the Italian Medieval and Renaissance City**
- You may also study in Italy by taking courses by other Canadian universities on a letter of permission
- You may also take language courses through the Università per Stranieri di Siena, Tuscany (University for Foreigners).
- Summer Work Program: participants come from member universities across Canada



German Studies - Study/Work Abroad Opportunities



- Numerous summer courses in various parts of Germany, Austria or Switzerland
- Other opportunities to study in Germany, Switzerland or Austria for one semester or for a full academic year
- Administered by Brock International or by other Canadian universities
- Exchanges with Germany for Dual-Degree Students in the Goodman School of Business
- Scholarships from the DAAD
