First-Year French Courses: Who Takes What? Academic Year 2023-2024

As of May 2009, the series of introductory French courses at Brock is composed of 3 courses:

- FREN 1F00 French I
- FREN 1F50 French II
- FREN 1F90 French III

Prerequisites (and special cases) are as follows:

- FREN 1F00 French I Ontario grade 9 French or equivalent or less (including no background in French)
- Ontario grade 10 no later than June 2018
- Ontario grade 11 French no later than June 2013
- FREN 1F50 French II Ontario grade 10 or grade 11 French or equivalent
- Ontario grade 9 French Immersion
- Ontario grade 10 Français
- Ontario grade 12/OAC French no later than June 2013
- FREN 1F90 French III Ontario grade 12/OAC French, Immersion or Français or equivalent FREN 1F50. Not open to Francophones (first language is French and attended a francophone school) who obtained a minimum of 75 percent in Grade 12 French.

NOTE

Students who have attended a francophone school (not immersion) throughout their studies and have obtained a minimum of 75% in grade-12 French enroll directly in FREN 2F00.

The Department does not make exceptions to these prerequisite specifications.
