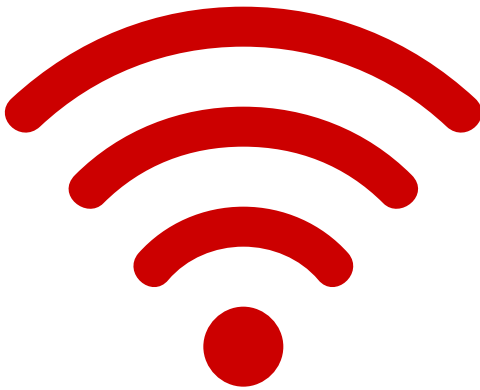

Configuring Brock WiFi for Mac OS

Overview

The Brock wireless network service requires a one-time setup of 'BrockWiFi' on your Mac device to enable the service with your Brock CampusID.

This guide will show you how to set up Brock WiFi on your Mac computer.

Setting up Brock WiFi on Your Mac

1. Open **System Preferences** from the Dock or the Apple Menu.



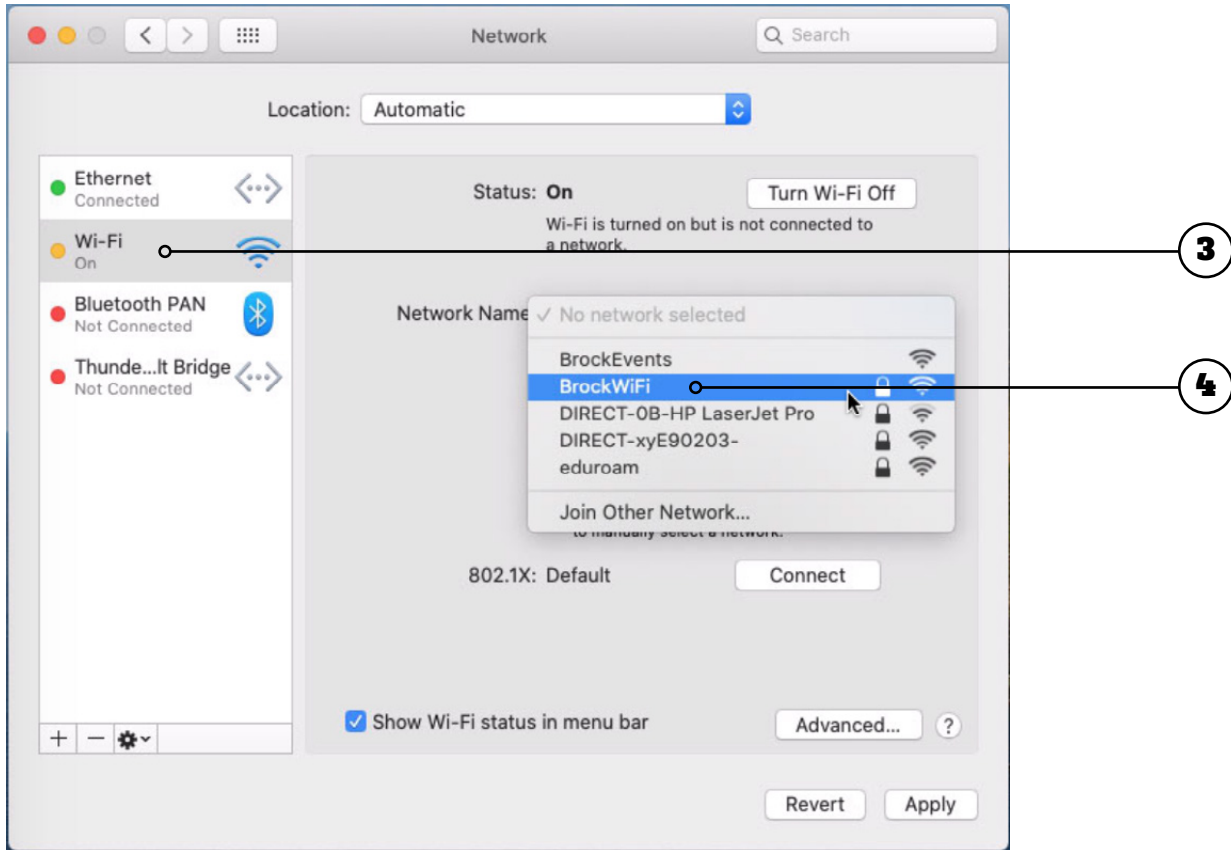

2. Click **Network**.



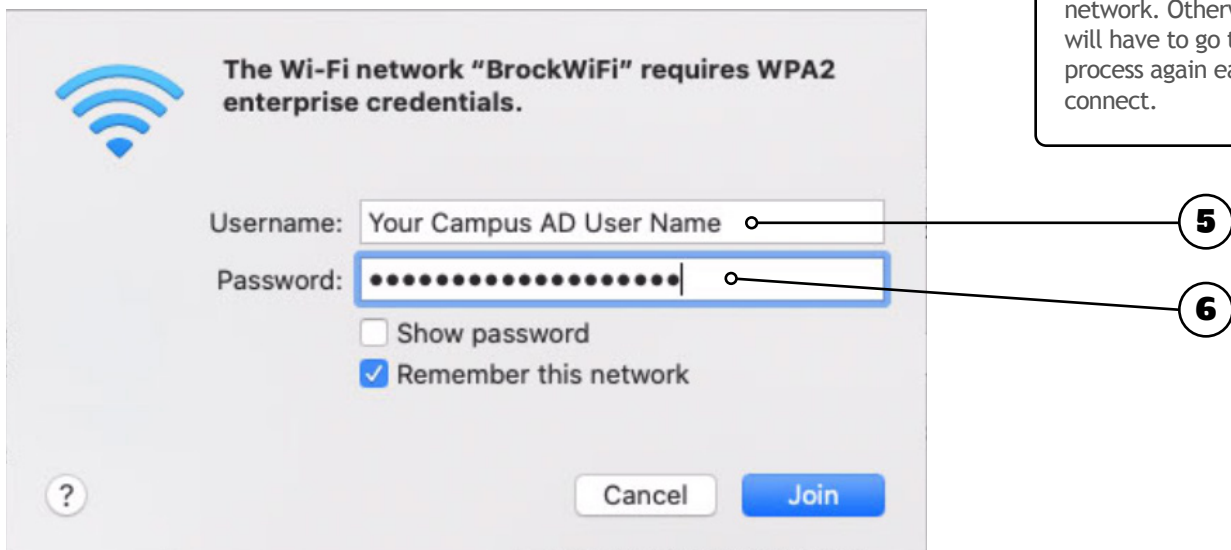

3. Select **Wi-Fi** from the panel on the left.
4. Select “**BrockWiFi**” from the **Network Name** drop-down menu.

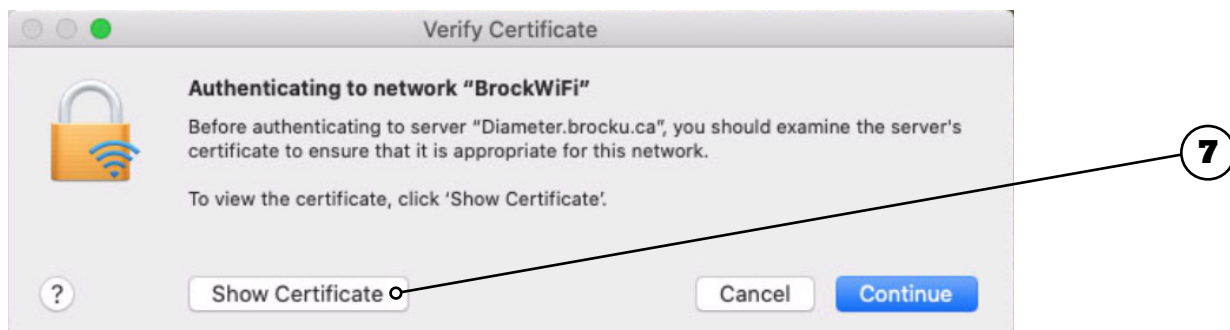


5. Enter your **Campus ID** (e.g., “ibrock”).
6. Enter your **Password**.

Ensure **Remember this network** is checked to enable access the next time you use Brock’s wireless network. Otherwise, you will have to go through this process again each time you connect.

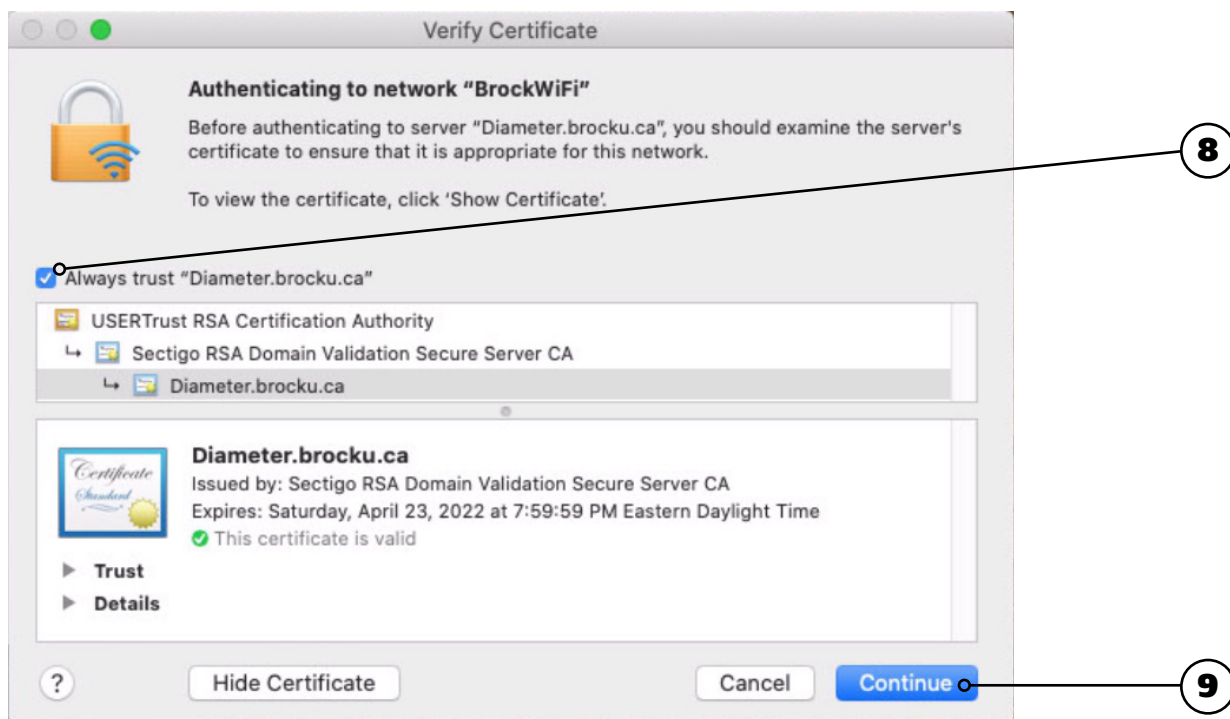


7. You may be presented with a screen to verify the server's certificate. Click **Show Certificate**.

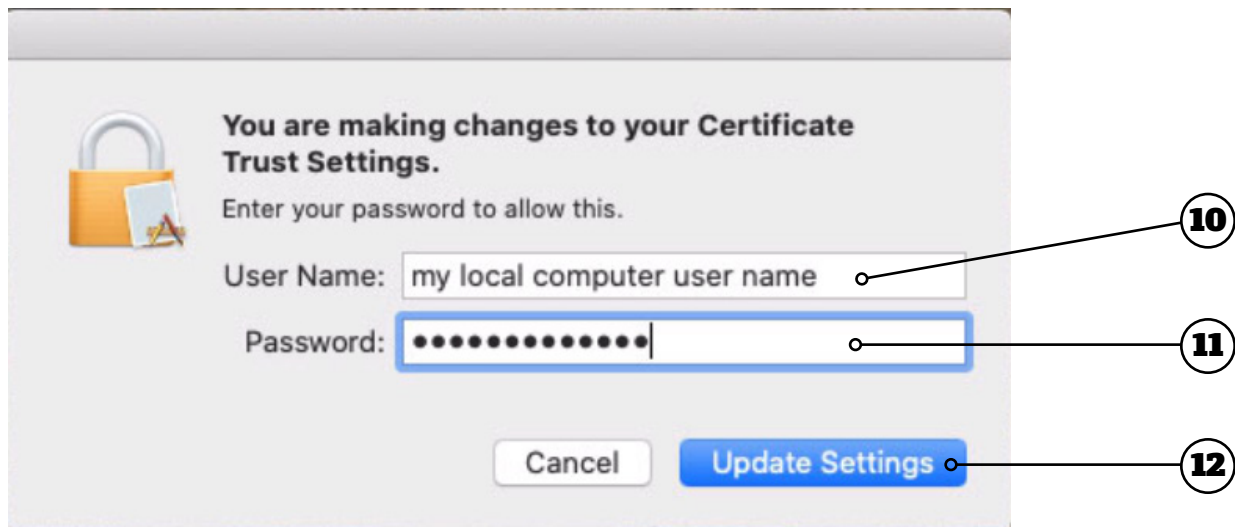


8. Check **Always trust "Diameter.brocku.ca"**.

9. Click **Continue**.



- 10.** You will be prompted for your local User Name and Password (these are the credentials that you use to log into your computer, NOT your Brock credentials). Enter your local computer **User Name**.
- 11.** Enter your local computer **Password**.
- 12.** Click **Update Settings** to confirm and save the changes.
