

Configuring Brock WiFi for Mac OS

Overview

The Brock wireless network service requires a one-time setup of 'BrockWiFi' on your Mac device to enable the service with your Brock CampusID.

This guide will show you how to set up Brock WiFi on your Mac computer.

Setting up Brock WiFi on Your Mac


1. Open **System Preferences** from the Dock or the Apple Menu.




2. Click Network.



- **3.** Select Wi-Fi from the panel on the left.
- 4. Select "BrockWiFi" from the Network Name drop-down menu.







7. You may be presented with a screen to verify the server's certificate. Click **Show Certificate**.



- 8. Check Always trust "Diameter.brocku.ca".
- 9. Click Continue.



- **10.** You will be prompted for your local User Name and Password (these are the credentials that you use to log into your computer, NOT your Brock credentials). Enter your local computer User Name.
- **11.** Enter your local computer **Password**.
- **12.** Click **Update Settings** to confirm and save the changes.
