### **Introduction**

This report provides student enrolment information for 2009-10 as of the official count date, November 1st.

**Section I** provides a full count of all students (undergraduate and graduate), by their major(s), on a headcount basis **for the fall term only**. Combined Majors and General/ Integrated Studies Majors are split between the appropriate units. For example, if a student has a combined major in History and Political Science, he/she is counted as "0.5" in History and "0.5" in Political Science.

**Section II** provides a more detailed headcount of all students in regular undergraduate programs (i.e. excluding pre-service and in-service programs), by major and by year of study, for **fall and winter** from 2005 to 2009, as reported on November 1st. Combined Majors and General/ Integrated Studies Majors are counted in full in each unit if the majors are offered by two different units. However, the student is counted only once in the Faculty total if the units belong to the same Faculty. In the example noted above, the student is reported as "1" in both History and Political Science and counted as "1" in the summary reports for both the Faculty of Humanities and the Faculty of Social Sciences. In the Faculty of Education, only students in the Adult Education (including Aboriginal Adult Education) programs and concurrent programs are included in this report.

**Section III** provides the number of declared minors by Faculty for the fall and winter of 2009-10. Students' majors are also indicated.






