Introduction

Retention statistics show how many students return to Brock after their first year of study. This report contains retention statistics across each Department, Faculty, and Brock overall. Retention within Departments and Faculties is also included to differentiate students that stayed or changed their initial Department or Faculty.

Graduation statistics show how many students have successfully graduated within 6 years from their first year. This report contains graduation statistics across each Department, Faculty, and Brock overall. Graduation within Departments and Faculties is also included to differentiate students that graduated or changed their initial Department or Faculty.

Definitions

Timing Definitions: The definition of "a year" for this retention and graduation report is the 12-month period from the beginning of a Fall term to the following Fall term. The Fall enrolment status is based on the official reporting date for the Postsecondary Financial Information System- University Statistical Enrolment Report (PFIS-USER) for the Ministry of Colleges and Universities (MCU).

Retention Rates: Retention rate is the percentage of first-time, full-time Bachelors degree seeking students in a given Fall term who returned to Brock University in a subsequent Fall term regardless of full-time (FT)/part-time (PT) status in subsequent years. For example, the "1st to 3rd year" rate for Fall 2012 first-time full-time Bachelors degree seeking students is the number and percentage of Fall 2012 first-time full-time Bachelor's degree seeking students who returned for Fall 2014.

Graduation Rates: Graduation rate is the cumulative percentage of first-time, full-time Bachelors degree seeking students in a given Fall term who graduated within six years of commencing their studies. For example, the "graduated in six years" rate for Fall 2012 first-time, full-time Bachelors degree seeking students is the number and percentage of Fall 2012 first-time, full-time Bachelors degree seeking students who graduated from Brock University by the Fall 2018 term, including those students who completed their courses during the summer of 2018.




Figure 1. How to read the Department retention and graduation tables.

Notes

 continued in subsequent years regardless of FT/PT status in subsequent years. The definition of first-time and full-time
 Bachelors Degree seeking students was redefined in 2019 as a first-time degree seeking student (from Secondary School and
 Non-CEGEP) registered for >= 2 credits for the Fall term.
- 2nd Year, 3rd Year, and 4th Year refer to the next Fall term and the two Fall terms after, it does not refer to students' study year (i.e. program progression)
- For the Goodman School of Business, the departments listed were created using students' Program Name in their first year of studies. Students are categorized by Program Name instead of Department because Goodman students are not eligible to concentrate in a certain Department until after completion of two years of study.
- Department of Applied Linguistics changed faculties from the Faculty of Humanities to the Faculty of Social Sciences in 2014. All
 charts include values from the Faculty of Humanities from 2012-2013 inclusive and values from the Faculty of Social Sciences
 from 2014-2022 inclusive.
- Concurrent BA Integrated Studies/BEd Program only includes students in the Concurrent Education program with a Major in General Arts.
- Concurrent BSc Integrated Studies/BEd Program only includes students in the Concurrent Education program with a Major in Science-General.
- Faculty of Education and Departments within the Faculty of Education are not reported as no students in these Departments or Faculties fit within the first-time and full-time Bachelors Degree seeking student definition.
















