Accessing ArcGIS Pro via Brock Credentials

The following steps assist with accessing ArcGIS Pro and ArcGIS Online resources using your Brock University credentials. For help please contact maplib@brocku.ca

- 1. Run ArcGIS Pro or go to https://arcgis.com
- 2. When prompted to sign in, you can either use your existing ArcGIS Online credentials or click "Your ArcGIS organization's URL" to access the Brock University portal.
- 3. Enter "brock" to complete the organization's URL. See image below.

Downloading ArcGIS Pro to your PC

- 1. Go to <u>https://arcgis.com</u> and sign in as per the previous instructions.
- 2. Once you are signed in, click on your username in the top right corner.
- 3. Select My Settings, then click Licenses (on the left).
- 4. Scroll down until you see the option for ArcGIS Pro.
- 5. Click **Download ArcGIS Pro** and then click **Download** to instigate the process.
