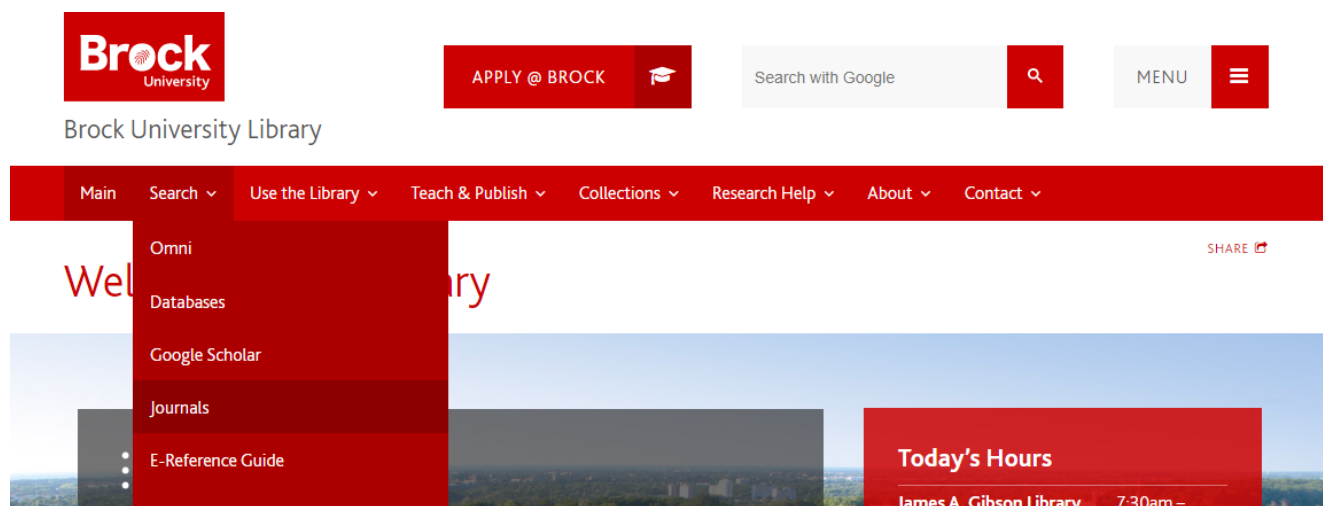
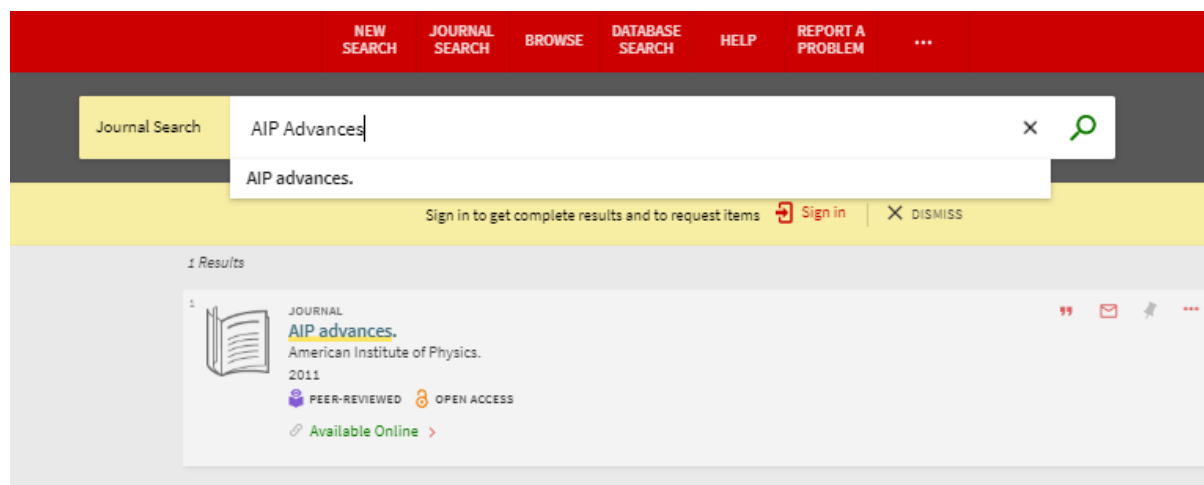


How can I find out what I can do with journal articles under library subscriptions

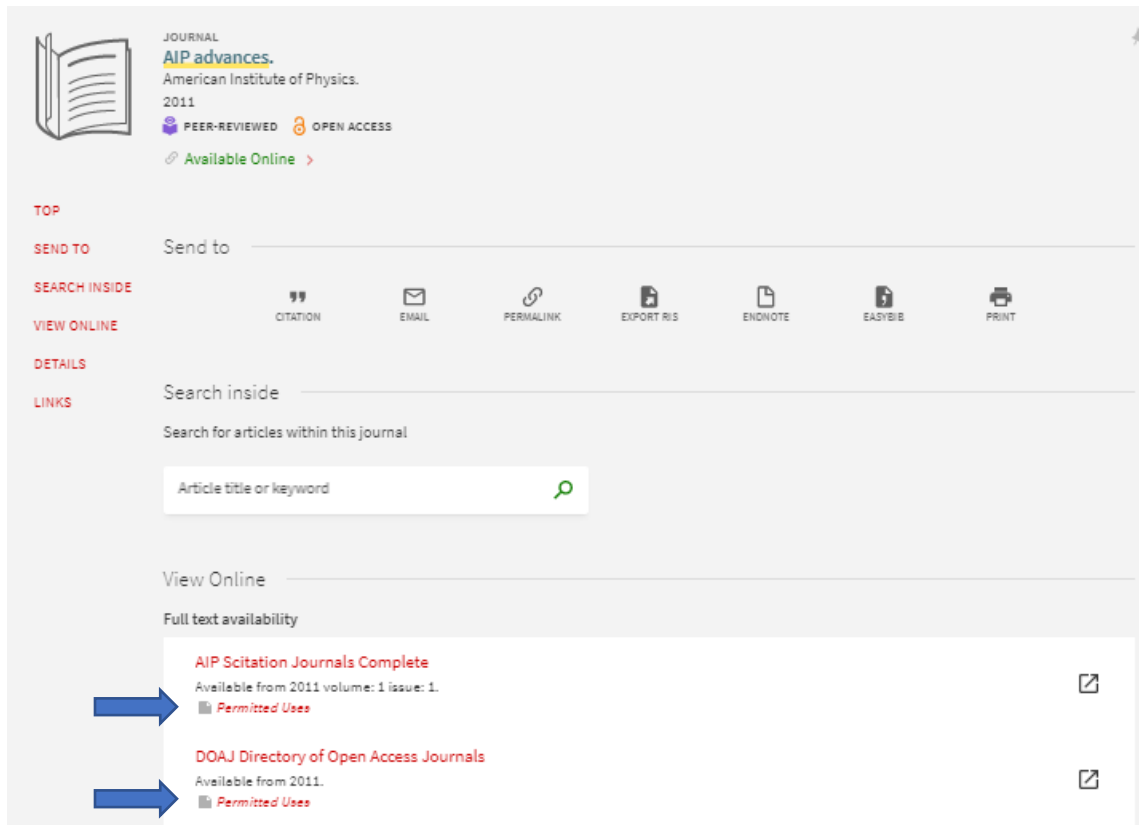
1. Go to the Brock Library's [Journal Search](#), available on the Library's homepage:



2. Search or browse for the title of the journal you wish to use, and hit enter. A list of results will display. Select the journal title that you need by clicking on the journal title:



- The record will open for that journal. Scroll down to see full-text availability. Below the full text link are Permitted Uses (indicated below). Right click on the Permitted Uses link and select 'Open link in new tab'.



- License terms are listed. If the Course Management System permission is 'yes', you can post an article in Sakai. If it is 'no', but you see a 'yes' to linking, you can link to the work instead.
