

Brock LINC Student Advisory Council

Overview

The Brock LINC Student Advisory Council is a group of students selected from each Faculty to act as advisors to the Brock LINC. Students on the Advisory Council will collaborate with staff to share feedback, provide insights on student needs, generate ideas and new initiatives, and be a resource to promote Brock LINC activities in their respective Faculty. The Council will also support the development of the Brock LINC community in the areas of creativity, innovation, research and entrepreneurship.

Positions on the council will be for one year (May to April) and upon completion of the one-year term, council members will be provided with a stipend of \$250.

The Brock LINC Student Advisory Council will consist of up to 10 members, representing the following breakdown of membership below:

- One (1) representative from the Goodman School of Business
- One (1) representative from the Faculty of Applied Health Sciences
- One (1) representative from the Faculty of Education
- One (1) representative from the Faculty of Humanities
- One (1) representative from the Faculty of Mathematics and Science
- One (1) representative from the Faculty of Social Sciences
- One (1) representative from the Marilyn I. Walker School of Fine and Performing Arts
- At least three (3) graduate student representatives

The council is open to both undergraduate and graduate students from each faculty. The council will aim to have both representations from undergraduate and graduate students.

Description

The Brock LINC Student Advisory Council will assist Brock LINC with the following activities:

- Attend monthly Student Advisory Council meetings
- Provide feedback and advice to the Brock LINC on new programs, events, activities and initiatives
- Provide suggestions for new events and activities based on student needs as related to the Brock LINC
- Promote Brock LINC events, programs, activities and services to students and peers in their faculty

Commitment

An ongoing commitment over the academic year is required for the Brock LINC Student Advisory Council members. Members are expected to attend monthly meetings, promote Brock LINC events, programs, activities and services to students in their faculty, and dependent on their schedule attend Brock LINC events.
