BROCK FMS FIELD COURSE DIVERSITY AND INCLUSIVENESS SCHOLARSHIPS

*BROCK FMS has joined the initiative of Ontario universities to provide field course scholarships to promote diversity and inclusiveness in STEM by funding 10 scholarships for Indigenous and Black students. The **\$500 scholarships** are to defray costs associated with enrolling in any field course offered by Brock FMS or any of the field-based courses offered by the Ontario Universities Program in Field Biology.*

Application procedure

- Submit a brief letter to deanfms@brocku.ca in which you:
 - Identify your eligibility: Black, First Nation (status and non-status), Inuit and Métis enrolled at Brock University.
 - Include your student i.d. and Brock email address.
 - Identify the field course to which you plan on enrolling and the start date of the course (date, month, and year). For Earth Science students, field trips not run by the department require departmental approval prior to application. For field courses under the Ontario Universities Program in Field Biology, students must have the approval of the Brock Biological Sciences Field Course Coordinator before applying.

Eligibility:

- Black, First Nation (status and non-status), Inuit and Métis enrolled at Brock
- Must meet eligibility requirements for registration in the course.
- Acceptance into the course.

Condition of acceptance of the scholarship: Students will submit a one page report (~ 300 words) describing the experience of participating in the field course within one month of completion of the course.
