FMS INTERNATIONAL RESEARCH COLLABORATION GRANT

The purpose of the grant is to provide support for the development of a collaborative research project of an FMS faculty member with a faculty member at one of three institutions: International Center for Chemical and Biological Sciences, University of Karachi; Monash University Malaysia, Kuala Lumpur; or University of Malaya, Kuala Lumpur.

Three grants are to be awarded annually as one of two options per award:

- (1) A 0.5 course release to provide time for the collaboration.
- (2) \$7000 to defray costs associated with the collaboration.

ELIGIBILITY COSTS (when directly related to the collaboration):

- Travel (economy airfare) and subsistence (meals and accommodation) expenses
- Expenses related to meetings/conferences
- Research supplies/materials
- Stipend for FMS graduate students or research assistants involved with the collaboration.

ELIGIBILITY

- Preference will be for full-time tenure or a tenure track faculty in an FMS department at Brock. Faculty from other faculties who have an affiliation (e.g., associate membership) in a FMS department or program will be considered.

- Demonstrate a strong track record in the research discipline of the collaboration.
- Preference will be given to applicants with Tri-Council funding
- May not hold more than one FMS-IRCG in an academic year.
Faculty must submit a report on any previously held FMS-IRCG awards before being considered for subsequent awards.

APPLICANTION REQUIREMENTS

A summary of the proposed research collaboration, including:

- Name and affiliation of the collaboration partner. The signature of the collaborator is also required. (Collaboration partners must be full-time faculty members at their home institutions.)
- The scope and scale of the project (up to 500 words).
- The timeline involved (proposed start date)
- A budget and budget justification (unless 0.5 course release option is selected)
- Research expertise required to complete the project
- CV

APPLICATION SUBMISSION DATES

There is no formal deadline. Applications will be considered on a rolling basis and a decision will be provided within 10 business days of the submission date.
