
Welcome to *The Mysterious Mind of Molly McGillicuddy* performed at the Marilyn I. Walker School of Fine and Performing Arts!

You will be looking for this building when coming to the show. There are some parking options available using the St. Catharine's downtown parking map:





Notice: the Icedogs have hockey games at the Meridian Centre on Friday, February 16th and Sunday, February 18th which may cause the need for cash in order to park.

Once you have parked, enter the front doors of the Marilyn I. Walker School of Fine and Performing Arts.



Now that you are in the building, please head to the elevator or the stairs, to the left of the lobby. You will be going to the **second** floor.






Please hit the button for floor two if taking the elevator.



Or please take the stairs to the second level.

Now that you are on the second floor, turn right and follow that hallway down until you see the ticketing table (please have your ticket(s) ready).



You will then be guided to the theatre and may pick your desired seat.

You made it!

If you need to go to the washroom, follow the same hallway where they checked your tickets and turn left before the elevator. You will then walk down that hallway (almost to the end) and the bathrooms will be on your right.



Please note that on Sunday's performance there will be a quiet room. This room allows audience members to experience the show in an alternative way.

The quiet room is located to the left of the elevator on the left side of the hallway in Studio D.
