



Walker Cultural Leader - Vincent Ho

The Department of Music is thrilled to host Juno-nominated composer and educator Dr. Vincent Ho for a dynamic multi-day residency as part of the 2026-2027 Walker Cultural Leaders Series. As Artistic Director of the Land's End Ensemble and former composer-in-residence of the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra, Dr. Ho is recognized internationally for his evocative compositional style that seamlessly fuses Eastern and Western influences.

This residency offers the Niagara community a unique opportunity to engage with one of Canada's most distinguished contemporary composers through interactive class visits, collaborative workshops and live presentations. On Tuesday, Feb. 9 as part of the RBC Foundation Music@Noon series, Dr. Ho will deliver a pre-concert talk followed by a performance of his works for piano solo and duet performed by pianists Elaine Lau and Joseph Ferretti.
