

VISA 3F99 HONOURS TUTORIAL APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS & EXPECTATIONS

HISTORY OF ART and VISUAL CULTURE (HAVC)

Deadline for application submission: Spring/Summer March 31 / Fall/Winter May 1

The Honours Tutorial in Visual Arts is defined as advanced study in an area of mutual interest to the student and the instructor. This is an independent project course in which the student works under the supervision of a faculty member who has agreed to take this role. You should contact the faculty member before you begin working on the application.

The academic aims and learning outcomes of 3F99 Honours Tutorial are defined by the student, in consultation with the faculty supervisor. This course option is designed to facilitate independent, sustained academic work that lies outside an area of study not normally offered in other VISA courses. The workload should be equivalent to a full credit course (two terms).

Students will work with their faculty supervisor (full-time faculty only) to develop a course outline that defines the learning and work objectives; what work is to be accomplished; a schedule of student-supervisor meetings, with work milestones and due dates; and a method and criteria for evaluation.

In addition to the approval of the Department, students must have an average of 75 in their major with 12 credits completed before the course begins.
