Call for Submissions

Secondary Schools in the Niagara Region are invited to submit up to 20 drawings produced by their secondary students (grade 11 and 12) for a juried drawing exhibition that will be held in the Visual Art Gallery at the Marilyn I. Walker School of Fine and Performing Arts at Brock University.

DRAWN 2025: Juried Drawing Exhibition for Secondary Students in the Niagara Region will showcase the artistic achievements of secondary students in Niagara and encourage their interest in drawing and the visual arts.

Submission Deadline: March 15, 2025

Notice of Selected Work: communication of jury results by April 15, 2025

Delivery of Selected Work to the Gallery: April 28-30, 2025

Exhibition Dates: May 6 – 17, 2025

Opening Reception: May 10, 2025, 1 pm – 4 pm

Submission Guidelines and Regulations:

Each secondary school in the Niagara Region will be permitted to submit up to 20 drawing submissions. All forms of drawing created by grade 11 and 12 students are welcome, including but not limited to: sketchbook pages, works on paper, digital drawing, non-traditional and expanded forms of drawing.

All submissions must be original (not reproduced without alteration from another artist's work); submissions may include work produced in or outside of school; work must have been produced within the past two years. If selected, artwork must be available to be shown for the exhibition dates listed and must be in good condition. Framing the work is not required.

Each school will select a faculty lead to act as their main point of contact and each school will run their own selection process to determine which drawings will be submitted.

The faculty lead from each secondary school will:

- act as the main point of contact;
- coordinate and collect student submissions;
- submit digital images of the entries on behalf of the students; and
- will be responsible for organizing the delivery and pick-up of selected work.

To Submit:

The faculty lead will compile a document containing all the digital images and information for the submission. PowerPoint, Word, or similar, should be used to build a single document with all the submissions included. Each digital image should be given its own slide/page and should contain the following information alongside the image:

Student Name (First & Last)

Title of the work, year it was produced

Materials used

Size in cm (W x H)

School Name, Grade 11 or 12

A submission slide/page should look something like this:



Please do not lock the contents of the document by sending a PDF, as we will need to be able to cut and paste the information to create wall labels.
