VISA 4F06 HONOURS STUDIO APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS & EXPECTATIONS

STUDIO

Deadline for application submission: May 1

Enrollment in the Honours Studio in Visual Arts is not guaranteed and is determined via competition. Applications are assessed by a Department Committee. This course is limited in enrollment to enable students to have adequate dedicated studio space. The course runs Fall/Winter each year. Students taking VISA 4F06 must also take the co-requisite VISA 3Q91.

VISA 4F06 entails advanced independent studio practice pursuing in-depth exploration of theoretical and methodological approaches to creation resulting in a critically engaged sustained body of work for public professional exhibition. The course includes readings, written assignments, rigorous critique, and the production of a substantial body of work that represents the student's own concepts and ideas as informed by research into contemporary discourses. Students are expected to work in studio a minimum of 10 hours a week. Studio space will be allotted at the beginning of the Fall term. Where possible and justified by the quality of work produced by students, the course culminates in a public professional exhibition.

In addition to the permission of the Department, students must have a minimum 75 percent major average, minimum 15 overall credits, in order to take the course.
