

OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Policy is to outline the University's commitment to occupational health and safety as required by the Occupational Health and Safety Act of Ontario.

SCOPE

This Policy applies to every Brock University worker, as defined in the Occupational Health and Safety Act.

POLICY STATEMENT

Brock University is vitally interested in the health and safety of its workers and committed to taking every reasonable precaution to protect them from occupational illness and injury through the provision and maintenance of healthy and safe working environments throughout its premises and activities.

Brock University is committed to providing and maintaining a respectful work and learning environment that is free from violence and harassment as required by the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act.

1. Programs & Procedures

The University strives to provide a hazard-free environment and minimize health and safety risks for all members of the campus community by adhering to all relevant legislation and, where appropriate, through the development, implementation and maintenance of internal health and safety work standards, programs and procedures.

Implementation of standards, programs and/or procedures will include a communication strategy and applicable training programs.

2. Responsibilities

Brock University maintains Joint Health and Safety Committees as per the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act.

Supervisors are responsible to work safely and comply with the requirements of occupational health and safety legislation, including, among other things, ensuring that safe and healthy work conditions are maintained in their assigned work area and with the individuals they supervise.

Supervisors shall ensure that persons under their direction are made aware of, and comply with, all applicable health and safety work legislation, internal standards, programs and procedures.

Supervisors are to investigate all health and safety hazards of which they become aware and take timely and appropriate action to mitigate risk.

All workers are responsible to work safely and comply with the requirements of occupational health and safety legislation, established internal standards, programs, and procedures. In the interest of the health and safety of all members of the community, workers have a duty to report health and safety hazards or legislative contraventions immediately to their supervisor or someone in authority.

COMPLIANCE AND REPORTING

This Policy falls under the jurisdiction of the Office of People and Culture. Unit supervisors are responsible for overseeing the implementation, administration, interpretation, and review of this Policy.
