

CAMPS AT HOME

Fire Starters

WARNING: you will need a grown-up for this one as you need to use the stove

Materials:

- Egg carton
- Dryer lint
- Candle wax (add a crayon for a fun colour)
- Old pot
- Tin can

Steps:

1. Eat some eggs and do some laundry 😊
2. Stuff the dryer lint loosely in the egg carton where your eggs were.
3. Set up a double boiler to melt your wax. You need a pot with water in it, and a can. We recommend not using one of your favorite pots and a can you can throw out.
4. Put your wax in the can and the can in the pot of water and heat the water. The wax will melt inside the can. Be careful and handle the hot wax with care.
5. Then you will pour the melted wax into your lint filled egg carton.
6. VOILA! You will now be a fire-starting master with the best fire starter.
