

What to Bring / What Not to Bring

Townhouse Style

PROVIDED BY BROCK

- Bed
- Mattress
- Zippered mattress protector
- Desk
- Chair
- Dresser
- Bookshelves
- File Drawer or desk drawers
- Small bedroom garbage can
- Small bedroom recycling bin
- Closet space or wardrobe
- Window coverings or blinds
- Telephone handset (in living room for unit)
- Wireless internet

All beds are standard twin/single size

- Basic cable (in living rooms only)
- Double-sided sticky pads for room decorations
- Oven/Stove
- Kitchen table & chairs
- Full-sized fridge with freezer component
- Microwave
- Large kitchen garbage can
- Living room couch, chair, & table
- Shower curtain
- Plunger
- Washroom garbage can
- Central Vacuum (Village only)
- 2 large blue recycling bins
- 1 large grey recycling bin
- Snow Shovel
- Fire Extinguisher

Except for the double-sided sticky pads, all items provided by Brock are University property and must remain in their original room.

WHAT TO BRING

Residence Living

- Bed linen, comforter, & pillow
- Plastic, metal, or vinyl organizational furnishings (see Allowable Furnishings)
- Clothes hangers
- Small compact fridge with no separate freezer compartment (max. 5 cubic feet, see Allowable Appliances)
- Fan with no heater component
- Laundry bag/bin
- Detergent & dryer sheets
- Towels & face cloth
- Bath robe
- Shower caddy
- Pots & pans
- Dishes & cutlery
- Dish soap
- Dish towels
- Dish rack
- Small kitchen appliances (coffee maker, toaster, kettle, etc. see Allowable Appliances)
- A TV for the living room (bring your own coaxial cable/cord)
- Cleaning supplies for kitchen, washroom, bedroom, etc.
- Mop & Broom
- Garbage/recycling bags
- Vacuum (Village has central vacuum)



Full length mirrors are provided in some, but not all bedrooms. There are large mirrors in the washrooms. We recommend waiting until after you move in to decide whether you want to purchase your own mirror.

Academics

- Laptop/computer
- Chargers & cables for electronics
- CSA or UL approved surge protected power bar
- Desk/reading lamp
- Student card

Personal Items

- Insurance protection for your property
- Personal documents (health card, photo ID, etc)
- Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, mouth wash, floss, shampoo/conditioner, deodorant, sunscreen, etc)
- Reusable mug & water bottle
- Headphones
- Ear plugs
- White board/message board
- First aid supplies (bandages, ice pack, polysporin, etc)
- Light-weight decorations (posters, decals, photos, etc)

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Furnishings that aren't allowed as per Allowable Furnishings
- Bed risers
- Any mattress not provided by Brock
- Mattress pads or toppers thicker than 3"
- Ethernet cable (there is only wifi in the townhouses)
- Candles, incense, or wax/oil lamps
- Pets (not even as visitors!)
- Fridges larger than 5 cubic feet or with a separate freezer compartment (see Allowable Appliances)
- Space heaters
- Beer or beer-type beverages (e.g. malt liquor) in any type of glass bottle
- Large-volume alcohol containers (kegs, "bubbas", Texas Miceys, etc)
- Alcohol paraphernalia (funnels, beer pong tables, etc)
- Ashtrays (all residences are non-smoking)
- Room alteration/repair supplies (paint, nails, window treatments, putty, etc)
- Adhesive materials for room decorations (scotch tape, sticky tack, duct tape, etc)
- Weapons, simulated weapons, or anything that could cause harm or be seen as intimidating.
- Anything illegal (e.g. illegal drugs)
- Drug paraphernalia (pipes, hookahs, bong, etc)
- Sub woofers & amps not recommended due to noise restrictions

This list is based on, but does not replace the Residence Community Standards. It is each student's responsibility to be familiar with the content of and abide by the RCS
