

Badger Cleaning 101

-THE KITCHEN -

Did you know that badgers are very clean animals?

What?! I did NOT know that...are you sure?

Let's practice good badger behaviour and begin our cleaning journey.

Supplies You'll Need

All-purpose cleaner

Disposable Scrub Pads/Brushes/Sponges

Garbage Bags

Broom/Dust Pan

Oven Cleaner

Cleaning Cloth/Paper towels

Oven/Burner Drip Trays

Plastic Spray Bottle

Bottle of Vinegar

Baking Soda

Where do I Start?

1. Talk with your roommates and come up with a plan to divide and conquer!
2. Visit the Dollarstore (cleaning items do not have to be expensive)
3. De-Clutter all of your surfaces/wash dishes and put them all away
4. If need be make your own All purpose cleaner! Put 1 cup of vinegar in a large spray bottle and fill up the rest with water. That easy.
5. Spray all surfaces and wipe clean (table, counters, fridge exterior and interior, sink/taps, stove top)
This even works great for spot cleaning spills on the kitchen floor [after you have swept]

Tips for the tougher areas

The Microwave

1. Fill bowl with water, add a splash of vinegar, place wash cloth in bowl
2. Set microwave to 1 minute
3. Grab cleaning cloth with dish glove on (hot!) and wipe inside microwave*
*if spills are not coming off easily, place everything back in microwave for another minute, should wipe away easily

Stove/Oven

1. Unplug stovetop burners^(yes they unplug!) set aside, remove drip trays and place in sink, clean these trays as you would dishes or follow same instructions as "The Sink"
2. Grab your oven cleaner, read and follow instructions on label!
3. Place drip trays back, put in tinfoil drip tray liners from dollar store and plug Burners back in. Place large oven drip tray from dollar store on bottom of oven

The Sink

1. Coat drains/drain plugs with baking soda, add a little vinegar, solution will bubble (science!), get scrub brush and scrub entire area and rinse with water

Fridge/Freezer

1. De-clutter! Throw away old / expired items.
2. Grab your All purpose cleaner and spray all shelves/wipe clean
3. Grab your small box of baking soda and stick in fridge (will trap smells)
