## **Tuition**

Tuition fees are approved by the Brock University Board of Trustees, in accordance with the tuition policy set by the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities. Tuition is assessed at differentiated rates between:

first and continuing year of study

Academics

- degree type and International student programs (ISP)
- domestic and international (visa) students

The fee information is provided for illustrative purposes for typical situations. The actual fees assessed may vary from these schedules.

### MEd (Course Based Route)\*, MAcc, MBA, MADS

For these programs tuition is charged on a per credit basis. Fees listed below are shown at a half credit rate. A full credit course will be charged two times the half credit rate. A quarter credit course will be charged at half the half credit rate.

### Final Stage Status Fee for MA, MSc, MBE, MEd (Research route) and PhD Programs:

Full-time and part-time students (Domestic and Visa (International)) who have completed all course work and have been approved by their graduate program for Final Stage Status will pay \$345.94 per term. Final Stage Status may only be awarded once and only for one term.

### International Cohort Program Tuition

Graduate International Cohort program fees are charged on a program basis, in Canadian Funds. Note that all applicable ancillary fees will apply for each registered term in addition to the program fee.
