Program Notes

- WRDS 3P18 is recommended
- **Minimum 70% undergraduate major average, 60% in remaining to proceed to 4th year and graduation**
- **Students must apply to the department to proceed to year 4 (Honours) of the program. Admission requires a minimum 70% major average and a minimum 60% overall average.**
- Satisfactory completion of the first three years of the Honours program entitles students to apply for a Pass degree
- Minimum of 3.0 credits numbered 2(alpha)90 or higher in undergraduate degree
- Minimum of 3.0 credits numbered 3(alpha)90 or higher in undergraduate degree
- **Maximum 8.0 credits numbered 1(alpha)00 - 1(alpha)99 in undergraduate degree**
